The Pope's message for the 51st World Day of Peace, which was celebrated on 1st January 2018, was dedicated to "migrants and refugees: men and women in search of peace."

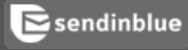
#### January 18, 2018: Roundtable for Peace in South Sudan and DR Congo is scheduled to take place in Rome, Italy.
